## 15 major tactics of satan that hinder believers

- 1) **Religious bondage:** Substituting so-called religious principles and practices that do not exalt Jesus, **for Jesus**
- 2) The deception that our vision of Jesus is about as big as it should be or can be
- 3) Instead of hating evil, we tolerate and play with evil
- 4) Failure to recognize that he who sins is the slave of sin and in bondage to it
- 5) Believing happiness is in self-gratification, possession of material things and recognition from others.
- 6) Religious pride that categorizes and condemns others rather than building up one another
- 7) Believers seeking **to be** served rather than **to** serve
- 8) Insisting that Jesus be power **or** wisdom rather than power **and** wisdom
- 9) Setting aside the commandments of God for the **tradition of men**
- 10) Teaching that the gospel is mostly worldly blessings that we can maneuver God to give us
- 11) Little recognition or thanks that Jesus within us **is** the hope of glory
- 12) The exaltation of the knowledge of man above God
- 13) Believing that **partial** surrender to Jesus is **full** surrender
- 14) Regarding God as common rather than holy
- 15) Little understanding that to know the Father and the Son is eternal life (John 17:3)

## Scripture verses referenced in the teaching:

- 1) **John 14:21** He who has My commandments and keeps them is the one who loves Me; and he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him **and will disclose Myself to him.**"
- 2) **Luke 24:49** And behold, I am sending forth the promise of My Father upon you; but you are to stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high."
- 3) **2 Corinthians 3:18** But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as from the Lord, the Spirit.
- 4) **Matthew 4:17** From that time Jesus began to preach and say, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."
- 5) **John 8:36** **So if the Son makes you free, you will be free indeed.**
- 6) **Isaiah 61:1-3** The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me, Because the LORD has anointed me to bring good news to the afflicted; He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to captives and freedom to prisoners; To proclaim the favorable year of the LORD and the day of vengeance of our God; To comfort all who mourn, To grant those who mourn *in Zion*, Giving them a garland instead of ashes, The oil of gladness instead of mourning, The mantle of praise instead of a spirit of fainting. So they will be called oaks of righteousness, The planting of the LORD, that He may be glorified.
- 7) **John 12:21** these then came to Philip, who was from Bethsaida of Galilee, and *began to ask him, saying*, "Sir, we wish to see Jesus."
- 8) **Revelation 12:9** And the great dragon was thrown down, the serpent of old who is called the devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world; he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him.
- 9) **John 16:8** And He, when He comes, will convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment;
- 10) **Psalms 139:23-24** Search me, O God, and know my heart; Try me and know my anxious thoughts; And see if there be any hurtful way in me, And lead me in the everlasting way.
- 11) **1 Corinthians 1:30** But by His doing you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, and **righteousness** and sanctification, and redemption,
- 12) **1 John 2:2** and He Himself is the propitiation for our sins; and not for ours only, but also for *those of the whole world*.
- 13) **1 John 5:3** For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments; and His commandments are not burdensome.
- 14) **2 Samuel 14:14b** Yet God does not take away life, but plans ways so that the banished one will not be cast out from him.
- 15) **Galatians 2:20** I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the *life* which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.
- 16) **Matthew 10:30** But the very hairs of your head are all numbered.
- 17) **Revelation 3:20** Behold, I stand at the door and knock; if anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and will dine with him, and he with Me.
- 18) **Colossians 1:27** to whom God willed to make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.
- 19) **2 Corinthians 13:5** Test yourselves to see if you are in the faith; examine yourselves! Or do you not recognize this about yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you—unless indeed you fail the test?
- 20) **Galatians 2:20** I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.
- 21) **Hebrews 10:19-22** Therefore, brethren, since we have confidence to enter the holy place by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way which He inaugurated for us through the veil, that is, His flesh, and since we have a great priest over the house of God, let us draw near with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.
- 22) **1 Peter 1:16** because it is written, "YOU SHALL BE HOLY, FOR I AM HOLY."
- 23) **Luke 24:49** And behold, I am sending forth the promise of My Father upon you; but you are to stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high."
- 24) **Acts 1:8** but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth."

- 25) **Acts 8:14-17** Now when the apostles in Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent them Peter and John, who came down and prayed for them that they might receive the Holy Spirit. For He had not yet fallen upon any of them; they had simply been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. Then they began laying their hands on them, and they were receiving the Holy Spirit. Acts 19 Paul at Ephesus
- 26) **Philippians 1:6** For I am confident of this very thing, that He who began a good work in you will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus.
- 27) **Hebrews 12:2** fixing our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
- 28) **Ephesians 2:8-9** For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God; not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.
- 29) **Colossians 2:10** and in Him **you have been made complete**, and He is the head over all rule and authority;
- 30) **Mark 4:26-29** And He was saying, "The kingdom of God is like a man who casts seed upon the soil; and he goes to bed at night and gets up by day, and the seed sprouts and grows—**how, he himself does not know**. The soil produces crops by itself; first the blade, then the head, then the mature grain in the head. But when the crop permits, he immediately puts in the sickle, because the harvest has come."
- 31) **Colossians 2:19** and not holding fast to the head, from whom the entire body, being supplied and held together by the joints and ligaments, **grows with a growth which is from God**.
- 32) **1 Corinthians 3:6-7** I planted, Apollos watered, but **God was causing the growth**. So then neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but God who causes the growth.
- 33) **John 4:24** **God is spirit**, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."
- 34) **Genesis 1:26-27** Then God said, "**Let Us make man in Our image**, according to Our likeness; and let them rule over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the sky and over the cattle and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth." God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.
- 35) **Zechariah 12:1** *Thus* declares the LORD who stretches out the heavens, lays the foundation of the earth, and **forms the spirit of man within him**,
- 36) **John 3:3-7** Jesus answered and said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, **unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God**." Nicodemus said to Him, "How can a man be born when he is old? He cannot enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born, can he?" Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. Do not be amazed that I said to you, 'You must be born again.'
- 37) **Luke 2:10-11** But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid; for behold, I bring you **good news of great joy** which will be for all the people; for today in the city of David there has been born for you a Savior, who is Christ the Lord.
- 38) **John 16:33** These things I have spoken to you, so that in Me you may have peace. In the world you have tribulation, but take courage; **I have overcome the world**."
- 39) **Matthew 12:41-42** The men of Nineveh will stand up with this generation at the judgment, and will condemn it because they repented at the preaching of Jonah; and behold, **something greater than Jonah is here**. The Queen of the South will rise up with this generation at the judgment and will condemn it, because she came from the ends of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon; and behold, **something greater than Solomon is here**.
- 40) **Psalms 66:18** If I regard wickedness in my heart, The Lord will not hear;
- 41) **Hebrews 1:9** "YOU HAVE LOVED RIGHTEOUSNESS AND HATED LAWLESSNESS; THEREFORE GOD, YOUR GOD, HAS ANOINTED YOU WITH THE OIL OF GLADNESS ABOVE YOUR COMPANIONS."
- 42) **Romans 12:9** Let love be without hypocrisy. **Abhor what is evil**; cling to what is good.
- 43) **Proverbs 8:13** "The fear of the LORD is to **hate evil**; Pride and arrogance and the evil way And the perverted mouth, I hate.
- 44) **Matthew 5:48** Therefore you are to be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect.
- 45) **Romans 8:39** nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, will be able to separate us from the love of God, **which is in Christ Jesus our Lord**.
- 46) **Galatians 5:22-23** But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.
- 47) **1 Corinthians 1:28-29** and the base things of the world and the despised God has chosen, the things that are not, so that He may nullify the things that are, so that **no man may boast before God**.

- 48) **John 15:2** Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit, He takes away; and every *branch* that bears fruit, **He prunes it so that it may bear more fruit.**
- 49) **Revelation 3:19** Those whom I love, **I reprove and discipline**; therefore be zealous and repent.
- 50) **Matthew 23:2-4** saying: "The scribes and the Pharisees have seated themselves in the chair of Moses; therefore all that they tell you, do and observe, but do not do according to their deeds; for they say *things* and do not do *them*. **They tie up heavy burdens and lay them on men's shoulders**, but they themselves are unwilling to move them with *so much as* a finger.
- 51) **Mark 7:9** He was also saying to them, "You are experts at setting aside the commandment of God in order to keep your tradition.
- 52) **John 17:3** This is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.
- 53) **1 Corinthians 2:9** but just as it is written, "THINGS WHICH EYE HAS NOT SEEN AND EAR HAS NOT HEARD, AND *which* HAVE NOT ENTERED THE HEART OF MAN, ALL THAT GOD HAS PREPARED FOR THOSE WHO LOVE HIM."
- 54) **Romans 8:18** For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory that is to be revealed to us.
- 55) **John 8:34** Jesus answered them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, everyone who commits sin is the slave of sin.
- 56) **John 8:36** So if the Son makes you free, you will be free indeed.
- 57) **Luke 18:1** Now He was telling them a parable to show that at all times **they ought to pray and not to lose heart**,
- 58) **1 John 2:16** For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the boastful pride of life, is not from the Father, but is from the world.
- 59) **1 Corinthians 3:1-4** And I, brethren, could not speak to you as to spiritual men, but as to men of flesh, as to infants in Christ. I gave you milk to drink, not solid food; for you were not yet able *to receive it*. Indeed, even now you are not yet able, for you are still fleshly. For since there is jealousy and strife among you, are you not fleshly, and are you not walking like mere men? For when one says, "I am of Paul," and another, "I am of Apollos," are you not *mere* men?
- 60) **2 Corinthians 5:17** Therefore if anyone is in Christ, *he is* a new creature; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come.
- 61) **Galatians 3:28** There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free man, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus.
- 62) **1 Corinthians 1:22-24** For indeed Jews ask for signs and Greeks search for wisdom; but we preach Christ crucified, to Jews a stumbling block and to Gentiles foolishness, but to those who are the called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God.
- 63) **John 6:63** It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing; the words that I have spoken to you are spirit and are life.
- 64) **Matthew 4:23** Jesus was going throughout all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every kind of disease and every kind of sickness among the people.
- 65) **Matthew 12:28** But if I cast out demons by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God has come upon you.
- 66) **Ephesians 1:3** Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, **who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ**,
- 67) **2 Corinthians 1:20** For as many as are the promises of God, **in Him they are yes**; therefore also through Him is our Amen to the glory of God through us.
- 68) **John 14:6** Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me."
- 69) **Colossians 1:27** to whom God willed to make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.
- 70) **Colossians 2:10** and in Him you have been made complete, and He is the head over all rule and authority;
- 71) **Colossians 2:6-7** Therefore as you have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, having been firmly rooted *and now* being built up in Him and established in your faith, just as you were instructed, *and* overflowing with gratitude.
- 72) **John 15:4** Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself unless it abides in the vine, so neither can you unless you abide in Me.
